1 I'mPOSSIBLE Creative Cheer Competition (Preschool-Primary School Category)

(Start any time and submit video by 30 June 2021)

Demonstrate the Paralympic values by submitting a creative video (up to 60 seconds) to cheer our local athletes on for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Perform a special rap, song, or dance as individuals, a class or a school!

The top 5 entries will receive S\$250 Popular vouchers, a trophy and a token from our Paralympians. Selected videos would also be published on media platforms to promote the Paralympic movement.

2 I'mPOSSIBLE Buddy Run

(Start any time and submit achievement by 30 September 2021)

Experience the Paralympic values by conducting a buddy run modeled after the guided run, an event for athletes with visual impairment at the Paralympic Games. Students pair up and take turns to be blindfolded – one sighted child guides a blindfolded child and they complete the run holding hands or towels.

Adapt creatively to your children's needs, such as allowing them to close their eyes instead of blindfold, walk instead of run, or complete the run sighted but standing within hula hoops.

After that, submit your achievement to SDSC. We will add your distances (in pairs) to a national tally. Our goal is to clock a total distance of 10,625 km, to commemorate our Paralympians' journey from Singapore to Tokyo, Japan, and back.

All participating children will receive a commemorative medal and certificate of participation.







Submit entries by 30 September 2021


Primary 1 to 3 students can take part in a drawing competition to express their vision on one of the four Paralympic values: Determination, Inspiration, Courage and Equality.




