



Demonstrate the Paralympic values by submitting a creative video (up to 60 seconds) to cheer our local athletes on for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Perform a special rap, song, or dance as individuals, a class or a school!

The top 5 entries will receive S\$250 Popular vouchers, a trophy and a token from our Paralympians.

Start any time and submit video by 30 June 2021.

I'MPOSSIBLE BUDDY RUN



Experience a Paralympic event.

- Experience the Paralympic values by conducting a buddy run modeled after the guided run, an event for athletes with visual impairment at the Paralympic Games. Students pair up and take turns to be blindfolded - one sighted student guides a blindfolded partner to complete the run while holding hands or towels.
- Submit your achievement to SDSC. We will add your distances (in pairs) to a national tally. Our goal is to clock a total distance of **10,625 km**, to commemorate our Paralympians' journey from Singapore to Tokyo, Japan, and back.
- All participating students will receive a commemorative gift and certificate of participation.


