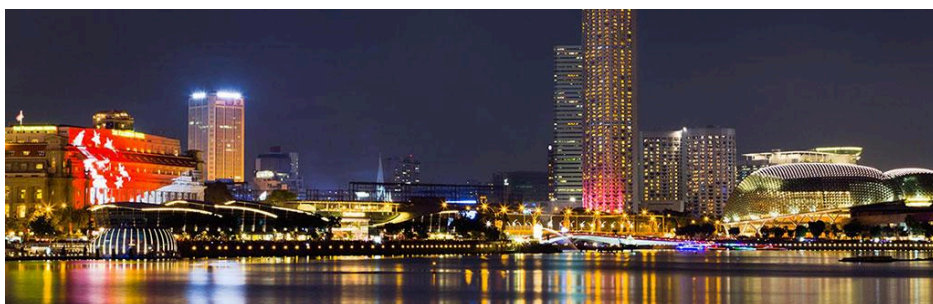
Accommodation Guide

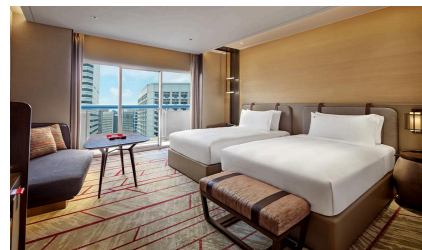
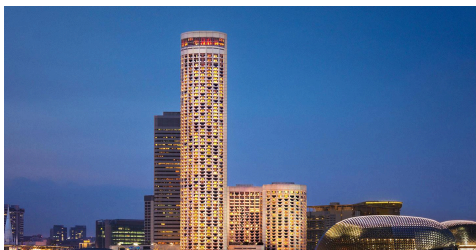
SWISSOTEL THE STAMFORD SINGAPORE
