
NO DIVING in Circle Swim Lanes; entry to these lanes is to be feet first, from a sitting position

Call Room

Swimmers would need to report to the call room <u>at least 15 minutes</u> prior to their event.

There will be no announcement for call room. Team in charge will be responsible to ensure swimmers report for their event.

For swimmer classified under S15- Athlete's official are allowed to tap the swimmer to start for the race



Result

Results of the meet will be posted on the results' notice board as and when they become available. No competitor, liaison officer or representative shall approach the meet officials for results.

Protest

Any technical protest or objection by a competitor or team shall be made to the Meet Director within thirty [30] minutes following the publication of the official results together with a deposit of **one hundred Singapore dollars [\$100.00].**

Only the Officers-in-charge or appointed representatives shall lodge the protest by filling the Protest Form.



MEDALS

Medals will be awarded to the first three placings for competitive events.

In the event of a tie for second placing in competitive events, no medals will be awarded for the third placing.

In the event of a tie for the third placing in competitive events, medals will be awarded for all winners.

Lifeguards / First Aid

lifeguard and a private ambulance with medic will cover the event.

Warm Up and the championship will only commence with lifeguard and medics on standby.
